Dear Parents,

It has been a stressful week for schools, families, the country and the world with Covid –19 now being declared as a pandemic.

As I'm sure you will appreciate, we are currently dealing with a complex and rapidly changing situation. My first priority will always be the health and safety of the pupils and staff in our school. Now more than ever, this remains our primary focus.

At present, no school should close in response to a suspected (or confirmed) coronavirus case unless directed to do so by Public Health England (PHE) or other relevant authority.

As I explained in the letter I sent home yesterday already in school we are ensuring children wash their hands

1. Every morning when they come in
2. After morning/afternoon break
3. Before eating
4. After lunch
5. After PE
6. After using the toilet

Frequently used door handles, light switches and stair banisters are also being cleaned at regular intervals throughout the day.

Children may bring hand sanitiser into school. We have also asked that parents/carers ensure their child washes their hands before leaving home.

There are posters around the school reminding staff and adults about the importance of washing hands and teachers have explained to children how to wash their hands properly.

Teachers have prepared work for children to do at home should we be directed to close.

This is an entirely unprecedented situation and we are following official advice from the government and the NHS. This advice is being added to on a daily basis and we are monitoring and responding to that as it is published. This official advice will underpin all the actions we take.

Whilst I appreciate that there will be a wide range of different views about how we should be responding and what action should be taken, I hope you will appreciate that I am duty bound to follow the official advice from government.
