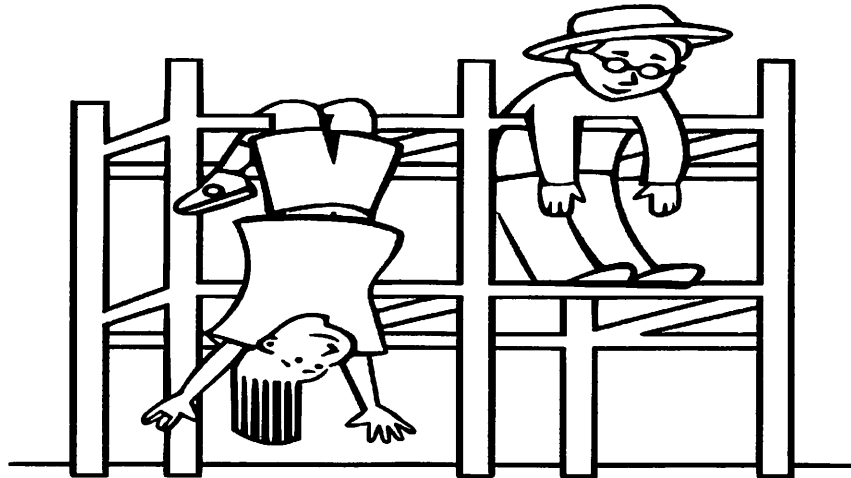

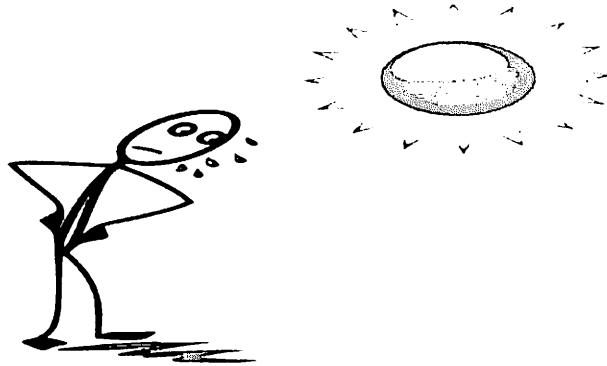
I am learning to write and illustrate a funny diary entry

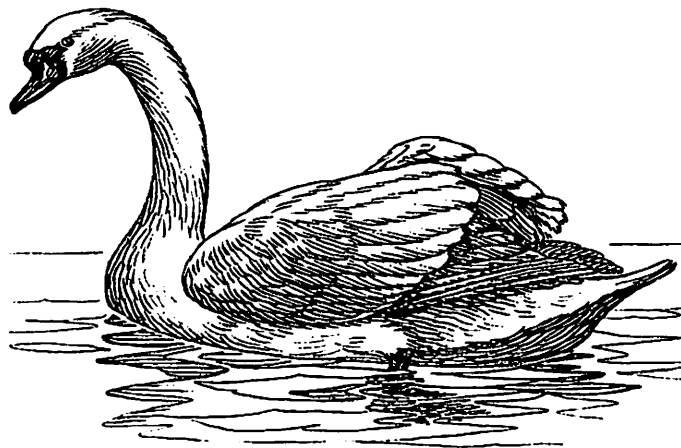
