Reminder TO APPLY FOR RECEPTION 2024

If your child was born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020, you must apply for a Reception place in primary school for September 2024, even if your child is already attending the school's Nursery. There is no automatic right of transfer from the Nursery class to the Reception class in the same school, and attending a Nursery class does not give any priority for admission to Reception class at the same school. You must apply online on www.eadmissions.org.uk.

Closing date for making applications is 15 January 2024.


Perfect Pet Competition


