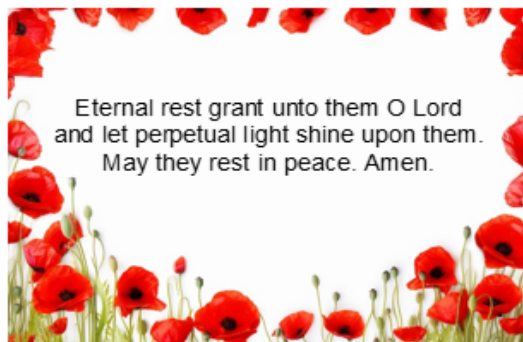
Remembrance

We will all be observing a one minute silence at 11am on Friday 10th November.



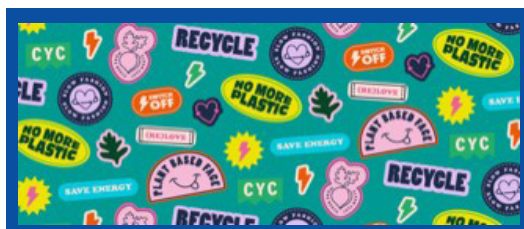
Thank you to Ms Fenton for the wonderful Remembrance display at the front entrance of the school which was created with the poppy wreaths that each class made.

Thank you Ms Fenton and Eco Warriors for the very informative assembly!



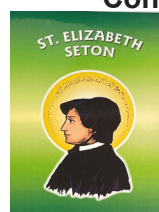
